Discussion regarding strategies of getting the legislative changes approved for the 2005 Legislative Session.

**Atty. Schwane introduced Atty. Vanessa Ramirez, who is the legislative liaison for the Department of Consumer Protection. Atty. Ramirez advised the Department that all legislative proposals must be submitted by July 30, 2004 for the next legislative session.**

**Atty. Schwane stated that for the July 13, 2004 Board meeting, he would supply the Board copies of the proposals that were submitted during the last legislative session along with the specific opposition raised by the Home Builders Association. Atty. Schwane advised the Board that the definition of engineering is a controversial issue and should be removed at this time from the package and introduce this issue under a separate Bill. The Board may consider working with the other professional organizations.**

**Atty. Schwane stated that another area that the Board may eventually consider some legislative changes would be the ownership of all business entities, such a general and limited liability partnerships.**

**Atty. Vanessa Ramirez's comments**

**Atty. Ramirez stated that an area of concern is that before the Department releases any legislative proposals, any controversial issues should be discussed with industry groups or professional organizations that are raising these oppositions. Atty. Ramirez stated that legislators who talk to her, state that there is a lot of opposition from industry groups and inquire whether or not the Department has talked to these organizations prior to the submittal of the legislative proposal.**

**John Hallisey suggested all members of the Board should speak during the public comment section of the public hearing. Atty. Ramirez stated that this would be crucial to have these comments on record and have the committee listen to relative issues because sometimes these issues can sway the committee members at the public hearing who have had their minds made up. This can give the opportunity to ask questions.**
