G-Other Items

The Board's policy is that until legislation is passed, the Board will continue reviewing application with accredited technology programs. Once legislation is passed, the Board will implement a grandfathering period for those who have begun these programs.

G-2 Reconsideration of application for Maher Elnagdy-

The Board considered Mr. Elnagdy's request and reiterated their policy of granting no waivers.

G-3 – The Board reiterated their policy of 7/15/03 regarding foreign undergraduate degrees which stated; with an evaluation of an equivalent foreign degree, the applicant should be allowed to take the (FE) Fundamentals of Engineering Exam without a specified period of time or experience.
