After all entries have been completed and proofread and any corrections made, the **complete set of returns should be photocopied** and both sets signed in the original by the Head Moderator, or moderator in municipalities with only a single voting district, at each place indicated and **deliver one set** of such returns either (1) by **fax to the Secretary of the State by 12:00 midnight on Election Day at 1-866-392-4023** and then deliver such return to the **Secretary of the State, not later than the third day after the election**, or (2) by hand delivery to the **Secretary of the State, Legislation & Elections Administration Division, 30 Trinity Street, P.O. Box 150470, Hartford, CT 06115-0470 not later than 6:00 p.m. of the day after the election**, or to the **State Police not later than 4:00 p.m. of the day after the election** and to deliver the **other set to the Town Clerk**. Use additional pages, if necessary.
