II. Department Of Public Health Updates

A. Investigations Update

Gary Griffin, Investigations Supervisor, Department of Public Health (DPH) reported that there are currently 13 veterinary cases under investigation by the DPH plus 3 cases involving unlicensed practice. 8 additional cases have been referred to the Department's Office of Licensure Regulation and Compliance for further review and/or action.

III. Office of Licensure Regulation and Compliance

Richard Alter DVM – Petition No. 2011-844

Ellen Shanley, Staff Attorney Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent was not present or represented.

Dr. Plunkett made a motion, seconded by Dr. Cianciolo, to adopt the Consent Order.

The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. O'Neill signed the Order which places respondent's license on probation and imposes a reprimand and a \$1000.00 civil penalty.
