As we progress into the New Year, we would like to thank all Board and Commission members who give their time and expertise to the Department of Consumer Protection in providing assistance and ensuring compliance with the laws created and established to ensure a protected Connecticut citizenry. The service you perform in your official state capacity is appreciated by the Department, your fellow Board or Commission members, licensees and consumers throughout this great State.

At this time, we would also like to take this opportunity to remind existing members and inform our newly appointed members to become familiarized with the Code of Ethics for Public Officials and Department of Consumer Protection Ethics policies.

In general, the Code of Ethics for Public Officials prohibits a public official or state employee from using his or her state title for his or her financial benefit or for the financial benefit of a business with which he or she is associated. As such, please refrain from using your board or commission title (i.e. "Real Estate Commissioner") on personal or business letterhead stationery, greeting or business cards, e-mails, calendars, or web addresses. In this manner, we may avoid even the appearance of impropriety and thus not risk possible violations of the Code of Ethics.
