Help Spread the Word - Public Hearings to Begin on Closing the Education Achievement Gap

The Connecticut Commission on Educational Achievement is set to begin a series of public hearings focused on closing the education achievement gap. The privately funded commission was established by Governor Jodi Rell by Executive Order in March. The Commission's goal is to close the achievement gaps between low-income and more affluent students.
