



## NOTICE OF DECISION TO TAKE ACTION ON AN IONIZING RADIATION PROPOSAL

**Proposal to amend and adopt Ionizing Radiation Regulations. The proposal repeals: 19-24-1 to 19-24-14 inclusive, and 19-25a-1 to 19-25d-11 inclusive. DEEP is proposing to adopt new regulatory sections for the control of ionizing radiation, as Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) sections 22a-153-1 to 22a-153-9, inclusive.**

The Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) hereby gives notice that it has decided to take action on the proposed amendment of RCSA sections 24-1 to 19-24-14 inclusive, and 19-25a-1 to 19-25d-11 inclusive.

DEEP held a public hearing on 16 April 2014 to receive comment on the proposal. DEEP proposes to revise the sections as noticed and after revision in accordance with the recommendations of the Hearing Officer.

The final wording of the proposal and the Hearing Officer's report are available for inspection and copying as described below. The Hearing Officer's report includes:

- (A) A statement of the principal reasons in support of this intended action;
- (B) A statement of the principal considerations in opposition to this intended action;  
and
- (C) A statement of the agency's reasons for accepting or rejecting such considerations.
