NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE INTENT TO AMEND A REGULATION

Notice is hereby given that the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Connecticut will conduct a public hearing on November 17, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. in room 600 at the Connecticut Insurance Department, 6th Floor, 153 Market Street, Hartford, CT. The hearing is being held pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. §38a-138 and will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 54, as applicable, of the Connecticut General Statutes; and sections 38a-8-1 through 38a-8-104 as applicable, of the Regulations of the Connecticut State Agencies. This hearing is being held to provide a opportunity for public comment regarding the intent to amend the Holding Company Act Regulations to conform to the Holding Company Act as amended by Public Act 12-103 and sections 126 and 127 of Public Act 12-2 of the June 12 Special Session.

All interested persons are invited to submit written data, views or arguments in connection with the proposed action within thirty days following publication of this notice in the Connecticut Law Journal to the State of Connecticut, Insurance Department, Attention: N. Beth Cook, P.O. Box 816, Hartford, CT 06142-0816. Oral comments presented at the hearing should summarize written comments submitted to the Insurance Department prior to the hearing. Oral comments will be limited to five minutes and must address the proposed regulations.
