Statement of Purpose

Pursuant to CGS Section 4-170(b)(3), "Each proposed regulation shall have a statement of its purpose following the final section of the regulation." Enter the statement here.

Statement of Purpose: The adoption by reference of these revisions to the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Standards will serve to update Connecticut Occupational Safety and Health Standards in accordance with Section 31-372 of the Connecticut General Statutes. On March 26, 2012 the federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) published notification of its modifications to the Hazard Communications Standard, which were effective in private sector general industry employment on May 25, 2012.

Conn. Gen. Stat. 31-372 requires, as an element of Connecticut's approved Public Sector-Only State Plan, that the Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Division (CONN-OSHA) adopt all occupational health and safety standards, amendments or changes adopted or recognized by the United States Secretary of Labor under the authority of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970.

These revisions modify the Hazard Communications standard to conform to the United Nations' Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals (GHS). OSHA maintains that modifications will significantly reduce costs and burdens while improving the quality and consistency of information provided to employers and employees regarding chemical hazards and associated protective measures. OSHA further maintains that the improved information will enhance the effectiveness of the standard in ensuring that employees are apprised of the chemical hazards to which they may be exposed, and in reducing the incidence of chemical-related occupational illnesses and injuries.



