Employment of Women Between 1 a.m. And 6 a.m.**Sec. 31-19-1. Health requirements**

The place of employment and all conditions and circumstances incidental thereto shall be such that, in the opinion of the labor commissioner, all of the provisions of the sanitary code for Connecticut establishments promulgated by the labor department and all of the provisions of the public health code of the department of health, as may be practicable, are met.

Sec. 31-19-2. Women not to work alone

No female shall be employed or permitted to work as the sole occupant of any establishment between the hours of 1 a.m. and 6 a.m.

Sec. 31-19-3. Inspection

All establishments employing women between the hours of 1 a.m. and 6 a.m. shall be open to the inspection of the commissioner or his agent at all times.

Sec. 31-19-4. Transportation

(a) Public transportation facilities by bus or train shall be available to the worker with such frequency as not to cause undue inconvenience and such transportation shall traverse a route between the place of employment and the domicile of the worker, comparable to the route usually traveled by such public transportation facility.

(b) In lieu of such public transportation facility, transportation shall be available to the worker, either by use of a personally-owned automobile or through facilities satisfactory to the labor commissioner, providing for transportation by the employer or by means of an approved car-pool arrangement.

(c) Transportation facilities shall be in full compliance with all statutes or regulations established for the protection of the user by appropriate state or federal agencies.
