## **SECRETARY BYSIEWICZ RECEIVES REP. DELGOBBO'S RESIGNATION**

### GOVERNOR WILL HAVE 10 DAYS TO ISSUE WRIT OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL VACANCY IN 70<sup>TH</sup> GENERAL ASSEMBLY DISTRICT

**HARTFORD:** Secretary of the State Susan Bysiewicz today officially received State Representative Kevin DelGobbo's resignation from office, effective January 6, 2009 at 12:00 p.m. Under state law, Governor Jodi Rell will have until January 16, 2009 to issue a Writ of Special Election to choose Representative DelGobbo's successor to represent constituents in the 70<sup>th</sup> General Assembly District. That special election must be held within 46 days of the issuance of the writ of Special Election.

"I have received Representative Kevin DelGobbo's letter of resignation from the General Assembly and this will take affect on Tuesday January 6<sup>th</sup>," said Secretary Bysiewicz. "Therefore, Representative DelGobbo will not be sworn in to serve another 2-year term on Wednesday January 7<sup>th</sup>. My office has notified Governor Rell of Representative DelGobbo's resignation. As soon as the governor issues the Writ of Special Election, we will notify election officials in Naugatuck when the special election will take place to choose the new representative in the 70<sup>th</sup> General Assembly District."

The 70<sup>th</sup> General Assembly district covers the eastern half of the city of Naugatuck.
