BYSIEWICZ REMINDS NAUGATUCK VOTERS TO REGISTER FOR MAYORAL PRIMARY

SECRETARY OF THE STATE REMINDING VOTERS OF DEADLINE FRIDAY MARCH
6TH AT 12:00 P.M. TO REGISTER FOR MAYORAL PRIMARY MARCH 9, 2009

HARTFORD: Secretary of the State Susan Bysiewicz today is reminding voters in Naugatuck to register to vote for the upcoming Mayoral Primary March 9, 2009. Eligible voters in Naugatuck have until 12:00 p.m. on Friday March 6th to register in person at the office of the Registrar of Voters in Naugatuck in order to cast primary ballots on Monday March 9, 2009. The winners of the Republican and Democratic primaries will face each other in the Municipal Election in Naugatuck on May 4, 2009.

“Naugatuck is the only municipality with a May election facing a primary for mayor,” said Secretary Bysiewicz. “I want to make sure everyone in Naugatuck who wants a say in the future direction of their town is registered to vote in the upcoming primary March 9th. In order to vote in the primary March 9th, eligible voters must register as Democrats or Republicans by Friday March 6th at 12:00 p.m. at the Registrars of Voters office.”

Polls will open from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. for the Mayoral Primary on Monday March 9th. Naugatuck is one of 15 communities holding municipal elections on May 4, 2009. The others are the towns of Andover, Bethany, Bolton, Union and Woodbridge, the Borough of Litchfield, the Borough of Newtown, the Borough of Stonington, the Borough of Bantam(Litchfield), the Borough of Danielson(Killingly), the Borough of Fenwick(Old Saybrook), the Borough of Jewett City(Griswold), the Borough of Woodmont(Milford) and the City of Groton.
