BYSIEWICZ REMINDS VOTERS IN BLOOMFIELD AND WINDSOR TO REGISTER FOR SPECIAL ELECTION

SECRETARY OF THE STATE REMINDING VOTERS IN 15TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY DISTRICT OF DEADLINE MONDAY MARCH 23RD AT 12:00 P.M. TO REGISTER FOR SPECIAL ELECTION MARCH 24, 2009

HARTFORD: Secretary of the State Susan Bysiewicz today is reminding voters in Bloomfield and Windsor who live in the 15th General Assembly District they have one week to register to vote in the Special Election to be held Tuesday March 24, 2009. The deadline to register to vote for the Special election is Monday March 23rd at 12:00 p.m. at the Registrars of Voters Offices in Bloomfield and Windsor.

“I want to make sure voters in Bloomfield and Windsor who live in the 15th district have the opportunity to vote in this Special Election to choose a successor to Representative Faith McMahan, who is greatly missed,” said Secretary Bysiewicz. “I encourage every eligible voter not sure about their registration status to call or visit their Registrar of Voters office. Voters can register for the Special Election up until 12:00 p.m. the day before the Special Election, so it is not too late.”

Polls will be open from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday March 24, 2009 at precincts in the 15th Assembly District to fill the vacancy created by the death of former State Representative Faith McMahan. The 15th Assembly District covers parts of Bloomfield and Windsor.
